NOTICE

The due date for **payment of fees for the** 2^{nd} **Semester for UG students is** <u>November 30th</u>. <u>2023</u>.

IMPORTANT NOTE:

- 1. Modes of Payment of Fees: The University only accepts any of these following modes:
- (a) <u>Online payment:</u> Student can login through the University's website <u>www.snuniv.ac.in</u> to pay online through credit card, debit card, internet banking, ewallets, Unified Payments Interface (UPI) etc. via TCS iON Self Service Portal. Student need to login using their TCS iON login credentials. For any login related issues, students may get in touch with the Academic Coordinators of the respective Departments.
- (b) **Demand Draft**: A demand draft drawn in favour of SISTER NIVEDITA UNIVERSITY from any scheduled bank in India as per RBI guidelines, payable at Kolkata to be submitted at the University Fee Collection Counter within the due date as mentioned above during office hours (10.00AM to 6.00PM) on any working day from Monday to Saturday.
- (c) <u>Debit /Credit Card payment</u>: Fee may be submitted through Debit /Credit Card at the University Fee Collection Counter within the due date as mentioned above during office hours (10.00AM to 6.00PM) on any working day from Monday to Saturday. Students & Guardians are requested to check their Card balance and daily transaction limits before submitting the fees through Debit/Credit Cards. The University will not be liable for any unsuccessful transaction through Debit/Credit Card.
- 2. No Cash / Cheque will be accepted for submission of fees, under any circumstances.
- 3. Students who are availing Bank Loan / Student Credit Card Scheme and who need Demand Letter from the University shall have to submit the filled-up <u>Demand Letter</u> <u>Request Form along with self-attested copy of loan sanction letter at the University</u> <u>Reception Counter latest by 11th November 2023</u>, to collect their Demand Letters. <u>Fee</u> <u>transfer document issued by bank should be submitted at the University Reception</u> <u>Counter by 30th November 2023</u>; in absence of which it will be treated as non-payment of fees.
- 4. Part payment against due semester or semi-annual installment fees is not allowed.
- 5. Direct Bank transfer / NEFT of fees is strictly prohibited and any such attempt shall be treated as non-payment.
- 6. Students' who would be appearing for the End Semester Assessments for the ongoing 2nd Semester (Autumn Semester), can get their Admit Cards on and from 08-12-2023, provided they have cleared their fee for 2nd Semester.
- 7. After the aforesaid due date i.e. 30th November 2023, fee may not be accepted and Admit Card for end semester examination may not be issued to the defaulters.
- 8. Fee related issue/ grievance: In case of any issue related to fee payment faced by a student, the same may be communicated through email to the respective Head of the Department. Please mention in the subject of email Student Name, Program of study, Department, Enrolment ID & Registration Number.
