Registration of the Academic Bank of Credit (ABC) or Automated Permanent Academic Account Registry (APAAR) ID (applicable for all PhD Research Scholars)

This has reference to the **Academic Bank of Credits (ABC) or Automated Permanent Academic Account Registry (APAAR)** developed by the National e-Governance Division (NeGD) of the Ministry of Electronics and Information Technology (MeitY) under Digilocker framework.

As per National Education Policy 2020, **Academic Bank of Credit (ABC) or Automated Permanent Academic Account Registry (APAAR)** is a national level facility to promote flexibility of curriculum framework and provide academic mobility of students with appropriate credit transfer mechanism to choose their own learning path to attain the Degree, working on the principle of multiple entry-multiple exit as well as any-time, any-where, and any-level of learning.

In this regard, all the PhD Research Scholars admitted till 2024 are hereby instructed to open the individual ABC or APAAR account on ABC portal through <https://www.abc.gov.in> on or before 20th December 2024.

Refer to the following steps to register & create your ABC or APAAR account:

- Step 1:** Visit ABC portal: www.abc.gov.in and click on **My Account** tab. Click on **Student** tab, then click on **Sign up** link and fill-up required information as per your Aadhaar card to register & create ABC account.
- Step 2:** After successful sign in select the **Sister Nivedita University** from the dropdown list of Universities and click on **Generate ABC ID**; and ABC ID or APAAR ID will be generated.
- Step 3:** After ABC ID or APAAR ID generated, take screenshot of the ABC ID or APAAR ID card.
